



WGC2026 Short Courses - Terms & Conditions for Participants

1. Scope and Role of WGC2026 / IGA

The short courses offered in connection with the World Geothermal Congress 2026 (WGC2026) are organized and delivered by independent third-party course organizers.

International Geothermal Association (IGA) and World Geothermal Congress 2026 (WGC2026) act solely as facilitators for:

- registration management,
- promotion and visibility within the extended conference programme.

WGC2026 and the IGA are not the organizers of the short courses and assume no responsibility for the content, delivery, or execution of any course.

2. Contractual Relationship

By registering for a short course, participants enter into a direct contractual relationship with the respective course organizer.

The course organizer is solely responsible for:

- course content and quality,
- scheduling and delivery,
- instructors and materials,
- health, safety, and operational aspects.



3. Registration and Payment

- Registration is completed via the WGC2026 website using a third-party payment provider (Stripe).
- A registration is considered confirmed only upon successful payment.
- All fees are stated per course and per participant.

WGC2026 / IGA acts only as a payment collection agent on behalf of the course organizer, unless otherwise stated.

4. Cancellation and Refund Policy

All cancellation and refund requests are subject to the terms defined by the respective course organizer.

Unless otherwise specified:

- Requests must be submitted in writing.
- Refund eligibility, deadlines, and any applicable fees are determined by the course organizer.

WGC2026 and the IGA do not process or decide on refund requests.

5. Changes or Cancellation of Courses

The course organizer reserves the right to:

- modify course content, schedule, or speakers,
- cancel a course due to insufficient registrations or unforeseen circumstances.

In such cases:

- participants will be informed by the course organizer,
- any refunds or alternatives will be handled by the course organizer.
